Overview

The **ImmunoE Leadership Program** fosters the development of leadership and professional skills needed to thrive in academic and industry careers in biotechnology. Through interdisciplinary collaboration, mentorship, and networking, trainees gain valuable expertise, expand their professional networks and prepare for successful careers as leaders in the areas of immunoengineering and immunotherapeutics.

Eligibility

This program is open to **graduate (MSc/PhD) students** who

- have completed the two-year ImmunoE NSERC CREATE training program, or
- whose research is in the areas of immunoengineering and immunotherapeutics, and who are in their second year or later of their graduate study

Benefits

- **Gain technical skills and cross-disciplinary knowledge** through expert-led microcourses, flexible online learning modules, and peer discussions at Work in Progress (WIP) meetings
- **Engage in scientific collaboration and knowledge exchange** by developing an innovative solution to a real-world challenge as part of a team-based ImmunoHackathon
- **Develop leadership skills** by mentoring junior graduate trainees or helping shape training initiatives through the ImmunoT&E Trainee Committee
- **Expand your professional network** across industry and academia through our annual networking event
- **Explore entrepreneurship** through SBME Propels and Creative Destruction Lab seminars
- **Receive career guidance** from postdoctoral mentors and a professional career coach
- **Connect with the biotechnology industry** by participating in tours of local companies
- **Get an opportunity to work with a biotechnology company** through an 8-12 month internship at the end of your graduate program
- **Earn a certificate** upon completion of the program
